**25, Wednesday  
Departure, Albuquerque**

We'll check in at the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport for the flights to Albuquerque. Upon arrival, we'll collect our luggage and then meet our tour manager and transfer to the waiting motorcoach for the drive into Albuquerque. Upon arrival, we'll check in at our hotel for a four-night stay.

**26, Thursday  
Santa Fe, Albuquerque**

Today an excursion is planned to Santa Fe. Our day begins with a guided walking tour of Santa Fe, following the Old Santa Fe Trail to the State Capitol, San Miguel Mission and Oldest House, and to the historic Plaza. We'll also visit the New Mexico History Museum. Next, we'll visit the Museum of Indian Arts and Culture for a guided tour during which we will learn about the cultural history and lifestyles of New Mexico's Pueblo, Navajo, and Apache tribes. In the afternoon, we'll have some free time for independent exploration and shopping. Later, we'll head to a Santa Fe brewery for Beer Choir. Afterwards we'll return to Albuquerque. (B)

**27, Friday  
Albuquerque**

We'll begin today at the Sandia Peak Tramway, the longest tramway of its kind, whisking passengers 4,00 feet up along a line of continuous Swiss-made cables. There is a small exhibit about local flora and fauna. Following some time to enjoy the view, we'll return to the base and then head to Old Town Albuquerque for a guided walking tour. The afternoon will be at leisure for independent exploration. In the evening, we'll head to a local Albuquerque brewery for Beer Choir. (B)

**Choose your own adventure!**

**Option A: Choral Exchange**

Members of Kantorei, Quintessence, and Coro Lux, along with any others on the tour who would like to participate in a day of singing, will have the opportunity to meet and sing together. Participants in the choral exchange will have an opportunity to hear three unique community choirs, and learn about their music and missions. Participants will also prepare a piece to sing in a mass choir with all three groups for an afternoon performance.

**Option B: Explore Albuquerque**

This group will visit the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center. The horseshoe shaped building is modeled after the Pueblo Bonito ruins in Chaco Canyon. The fascinating museum traces the history of the Pueblo communities in New Mexico. In the afternoon we'll head to the ABQ Biopark to visit the Botanic Garden which has plants from the American Southwest and from around the world. Following our visit here, we'll have some free time. Later in the afternoon, we'll attend a joint concert performance of Kantorei, Quintessence, and Coro Lux, and a mass choir of participants in the choral exchange day.

Following the concert, all tour participants are invited to a dinner at a local restaurant. Note: This dinner is not included as a part of your tour package (B)
